### **ORGANISATIONAL STRUCTURE**

Nottingham News Centre has an excellent reputation for heritage management and media production. NNC employs around 5 staff and 10 volunteers. The day-to-day management of Nottingham News Centre is the responsibility of Executive Board.

### **OUR POLICY ON SLAVERY AND HUMAN TRAFFICKING**

Nottingham News Centre is committed to ensuring that there is no modern slavery or human trafficking in its supply chains or in any part of its business. Nottingham News Centre Modern Slavery and Human Trafficking Policy reflects its commitment to acting ethically and with integrity in all its business relationships and to implementing and enforcing effective systems and controls to ensure slavery and human trafficking is not taking place anywhere in its supply chains.

#### **Our Supply Chains**

Nottingham News Centre purchases goods, services and works from a diverse range of suppliers, across a number of categories. It is recognised that the Nottingham News Centre supply chains are global and complex when considering multi-tier suppliers, therefore these categories of spend have helped inform both the prioritisation and risk impact as Nottingham News Centre continues to develop its due diligence processes.

Nottingham News Centre continues to meet its obligations under the act, it encourages the supply chain to sign up to the tools which have been identified.

Nottingham News Centre also undertakes a significant amount of collaborative work with partners and supporting organisations and it is acknowledged that this area will also be included as part of Nottingham News Centre's approach when adopting due diligence processes in relation to its obligations under the Modern Slavery Act 2015.
